

## Parthenocissus species

Parthenocissus tricuspidata

### Propagation

Parthenocissus is very easy to propagate by seed!

Seed requires no specific pre-treatment. Sow in good quality propagation mix, planting 1.25cm deep and water immediately with a misting attachment to avoid dislodging the seeds in the tray/tube.

Keep soil moist but not wet and seeds will germinate from 4 weeks.

You can also sow in situ in the garden by cultivating the soil to a depth of 15cm and enrich with compost or well rotted manure. Plant seeds 1.25cm deep and water immediately with a sprayer or misting attachment to ensure that you don't dislodge the seeds.

Keep soil moist but not wet and seeds should germinate from 4 weeks.
