

Agapanthus species

PRE-TREATMENT – No pre-treatment is required for this species.

SOWING – Best time to sow seeds is in Autumn and Spring.

Use a good quality seed raising media with added perlite to increase drainage.

Put media into seed trays and moisten, sprinkle seeds on top of the media and cover lightly with seed raising media or washed river sand, no more than 5mm.

Water with a fine mist spray as to not dislodge seeds.

Place trays into a warm area where seeds have sunlight or bright indirect light for at least 6 hours per day.

Keep the seeds moist but not wet, don't allow to dry out.

Move the seeds into a bright well lit area after they germinate, this will take about 4 weeks.

CULTIVATION – Prick out seedlings out and transplant when they are big enough to handle.

Be sure to put seedlings in a protected frost free area or in a greenhouse over Winter.

Transplant into bigger pots when required.

Plant outdoors after the danger of frosts has passed in Spring.
