

Caesalpinia species

Propagation

Propagation is straightforward from seed although they need to be soaked overnight in hot water to overcome the very hard seed coating. Start with water at just off boiling point and let the seed soak overnight.

Sow seed in a medium of one part coarse washed river sand, one part fine sand and one part chopped peat moss. Sow the seed sideways and cover lightly to the depth of the diameter of the seed. Germination occurs from the end of the seed.
