Diploglottis species

Propagation

PRE-TREATMENT – No pre-treatment required for this species

SOWING – Best propagated in Autumn, Spring or Summer.

Use a good quality seed raising mix with added perlite for added drainage.

Use individual larger pots or tubes and fill with seed raising media mix and moisten.

Sow one seed in each pot and lightly cover with media.

Water in gently with a mist spray and place pots in a warm, sunny position or in a greenhouse.

Keep moist and don't allow to dry out.

Seeds should start sprouting in 1 - 6 weeks, but can take as long as 8 weeks to start. Germination rates can be low to high but depending on environmental conditions.
